Subject: Lead contamination in the Crum Creek

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Dear Board Of Governors,

CRC Watersheds Association is a nonprofit organization founded in 1970 with the mission to protect, conserve, and restore the natural resources of the Chester, Ridley, and Crum Creek Watersheds.

Your club is currently running a trapshooting shooting range next to the Crum creek with lead pellets from your gunners being fired over a section of the Crum Creek and into the floodplain that flows into the Crum Creek Watershed. Our concern is the contamination of this critical water resource that is the source of public drinking water. In addition to putting our public water at risk, this lead can also be ingested by waterfowl and other wildlife. Since our mission is to preserve and protect the Crum creek, we want to ask you to stop this unnecessary and hazardous activity.
